

Self-Portrait Tea Towels

Self portrait tea towels are great fun to create, and a great memento or keepsake for all sorts of occasions. A self-portrait tea towel can be created as a fundraising tool for school classes and colleges. They are also great for hen or stag parties, weddings, work places, big birthday celebrations, friendship groups and so much more!



What if I already have the whole image ready to print?

If you already have the means to scan your images in and have created the whole image digitally, then that's great!

Simply select 'Artwork File Ready' and upload a high resolution image when placing your order. Our preferred file formats are EPS, AI and PDF however we can also work with TIFF and JPEG files as long as the resolution is at least 300 dpi and the image is physically larger than 25cm wide.

What if I am unable to create the digital artwork myself?

If you are unable to scan the images and create the finished digital artwork yourself, don't worry we can help you. We simply need you to post the individual drawings to us and we can scan them in and arrange them to create a high resolution image ready for printing.

REMEMBER

If you wish to include a logo, names or event details in the design, you will need to include this in your digital artwork or send this over to us separately for us to add to the centre of the design.

How Does it Work?

Step 1

Provide each child or person taking part with an appropriate sized piece of paper - typically A6 or smaller. Postcard or business card sizes work best. Then it's time to get them drawing!

TOP TIP

It's better if everyone can use the same type of pen, this way each drawing will have a similar finish. We recommend a good black fibre pen, preferably no less than 0.5mm in thickness to ensure no lines are missing when scanned in.

Please be aware that pencil or crayon drawings will not reproduce well, and if you would like your images converting to a different single colour then please specify this when you order. If you have very young children you could do hand prints or even foot prints as a variation to the typical drawings.



Step 2

Artwork File Ready:

If you are creating the full image yourself you'll need to scan each drawing and start arranging them in a file. The printable area is 37cm by 60cm so this is the size the file needs to be. You need to scan them in using a resolution of 300dpi or more, this will give the best image quality possible. The finished file will need to be either an EPS, AI, PSD or PDF. If you are not able to save in one of these formats, we can use TIFF or JPEG files. Make sure you export with a high resolution of at least 300dpi.


Send in by Post:

If you need some help scanning in the drawings and getting them ready to print simply pack them all up together and send them to us along with any logo or other details you want to include in the design. Don't forget to include your order number in the parcel so we can match it up correctly when it arrives. If you have a particular layout you want us to follow then you will need to number the images and provide a grid layout of how you would like it to look (see example below). If you would like all the drawings to be a specific colour you will need to let us know so we can apply it to the finished design as well.

TOP TIP

When numbering your images make sure you use a pencil on the back so that the numbers don't show up when scanned in.

Step 3

Fill out the details required on the website, select whether you have a finished artwork file ready to upload or if you are planning to send them by post. Upload the artwork if you have it, and if you would like one of our borders adding, type the name of your chosen border into the box. Then simply add to basket and complete your order. If you would like to receive sms notifications from our courier once your order has been shipped, please ensure you enter your mobile number as the delivery telephone number at checkout

Step 4


Simply sit back and let our team get to work preparing a digital proof for your approval.

If you uploaded your artwork when placing your order we will check the digital image is the correct size and quality. If you have sent your art by post we will scan in your images and edit them as necessary to get them ready to print. We'll then lay out the different drawings following any instructions you may have sent or in the best way possible if you haven't.

Once you receive the proof by email, let us know as soon as possible if you need any adjustments made, and once you're happy with how the design looks, email us to say the proof is approved. Your order will then be scheduled for printing.


REMEMBER

The price shown on our website and paid when you place your order includes up to 3 digital proofs. If you require any further changes after receiving a third proof, there will be an additional admin fee to be paid.




Step 5

Once we have your approval, your order will join the production queue to be printed by one of our team. Once printing is complete we will pack and ship your order. You will receive an email from our website including tracking information, and you will also receive notifications directly from our courier once they have collected your parcel from us.
